Logline:

Waterman follows a new hero - Daniel Cruz De Gonzales, who has the uncanny ability to manipulate and BECOME water, during a time when the world values nothing more than the ownership of H2O.

Genre: Action, Post-Apocalyptic, Suspense

Target Audience: All Ages

Concept:

In New York, August 3rd, 2075 - due to increased global warming, the world has become void of all bodies of water. Ordinary people are left desperate, only able to harvest water from the brief morning mist. Luckily, one man, Daniel Cruz De Gonzales, happenes to have the unfathomable ability to manipulate and create water.

Years before the desolation of the planet, Daniel was a young man in college, studying biotechnology under the brilliant, Nobel Prize winning Dr. Lorensky. At that time, Dr. Lorensky already knew that humans had missed their opportunity to heal the earth. However, he believed that despite humanity's shortcomings, they deserved another chance at survival. So, he created an antidote to cure the world of all viruses, diseases, and other ailments and called it "Aqueous Plasma".

After several animal based trials at his lab in Cancun, Dr. Lorensky was confident that "Aqueous Plasma" was ready for human consumption. He knew, however, that there was no way to fully understand its long term effects on humans. Daniel, having worked closely under Dr. Lorensky for years, had earned his trust as both an intelligent biotech engineer and also as a brave, kind hearted man. Dr. Lorensky knew that Daniel would be the perfect first recipient of "Aqueous Plasma" and therefore trusted him to kick start the human trials.

Unfortunately, Marcus Reinhardt, the college rival of Daniel, had also followed Dr. Lorensky's work closely over the years - even patenting it off as his own. Themes/Main Perspectives:

Main Characters:

Daniel Cruz De Gonzales - "Waterman", a hardworking biotech engineer, former head of the successor of Greenpeace, ready and willing to use his abilities to help save the world.

Dr. Joseph Lorensky - a biotech engineer and professor of paranormal psychic abilities. Father to Carina and long time Professor/Mentor to Daniel and Marcus.

Carina Lorensky - a beautiful, young woman with shocking intelligence. A talented coder of virtual reality and every bit her brilliant father's daughter.

Marcus Reinhardt - a wealthy aristocrat that studied alongside Daniel in college, he sees the world only in ways that provide him what he wants and will stop at nothing to get his way.

Main Secondary Characters:

Chief Carlos Delgado - a beat cop who quickly rises to power after arresting Daniel for the murder of Dr. Lorensky

Captain Enrique Marinez - a beat cop, ex-partner to Carlos, who knows that the evidence supporting Daniel's arrest has been tampered with and even after losing his badge, he does everything he can to fight for truth.

Laura Montgomery - a reporter who quickly befriends and saves Carina. She is completely average in both looks and intelligence but has a misleading secret that puts her right in the center of all the action.

Ted - a close family friend of Dr. Lorensky and a second father to Carina. He does everything he can to help both her and Daniel after Joseph's death.
